**Join us on the 2019 adult mission trip  
for Hurricane Florence relief**

**Saturday, February 23 - Sunday, March 3  
Cost: approx. \$400 + meals while traveling, personal  
expenses, group dinner night out**

Our destination is coastal North Carolina and we'll be staying at Camp Albemarle, a Christian camp located (similar to Lutherdale in Elkhorn) on the Bogue Sound in Newport, NC. We'll be traveling in vans (11 passengers + luggage), with two 10 hour days of driving and a stay near the Ohio/West Virginia state line. Those choosing to fly should book flights to Wilmington, NC.



Our work will range from hurricane clean up to rebuilding, plus some work at the camp. A team of volunteers may be needed to help plan and prepare meals.

There are 41 people signed up so far, including Pastor Roy and Jean, with room for more. Talk with either one of us ASAP if you are interested in going.

The final planning meeting for the trip is scheduled for Tuesday, January 29 at St. Luke's in Waukesha.

Jan Frans leads The Oasis Project. She had a vision that ruminated in her heart for about 11 years to serve the community with acts of kindness and love. Launched in 2015, the Project provides tutoring in reading and math, provided primarily through retired teachers.

Their mission is to offer a hand up to the under-served and under-resourced children, individuals and families in Western Waukesha County. Families of these children are unable to afford to hire a much-needed tutor or may have extenuating circumstances necessitating our service. Because of the relative affluence in our community, these children do not receive help through typical grants and services that would be available to them if they lived in an area with a higher incidence of poverty.

All Saints has two libraries

All Saints has a resource library in the Gathering room and a Little Free Library outside the education entrance. The revitalized resource library is still a work in progress as we continue to catalog and organize the books, CDs and DVDs. Quite a few new books have been added and there is something for all ages. Books can be signed out on the small desk next to the children's books. Returned books should be placed in the bucket underneath the desk.

Please note if you have books you would like to donate to the resource library, bring them to the church office - don't just put them on the shelves.

The Little Free Library, designed and built by Al Theis, has been in use since the summer of 2014 and is a resource to the surrounding community. You can take a book, leave a book, or both. It is also a site for geocaching.
