**Goodbye Instant Church Directory .... Hello Breeze online church directory**



Those of you who utilize the Instant Church Directory app on your phones will not be able to access it after mid-August. In a continuing effort to be good stewards of our resources, we are switching over to the Breeze Church Management System directory, easily accessible through the Breeze app. The result is a cost savings to the congregation.

Last March you should have received an email from the church office inviting you to create your own member account in Breeze. *By accepting the invitation, you will be able to see your personal information and make updates when changes occur (new email address, phone number, etc.) You can also upload a new picture. Updated photos are important as Breeze will become our online member/photo directory.*

*Once you have created your member account, you will be able to download the Breeze app to your mobile device. The app will provide easy access to the online member directory, as well as your personal record of contributions. Plus, it provides the opportunity to give online via ACH or credit card.*

*No one other than the financial team will be able to see your personal financial information through Breeze. You will be able to view other people's contact info.*
